Home Campaign Progress: 83%

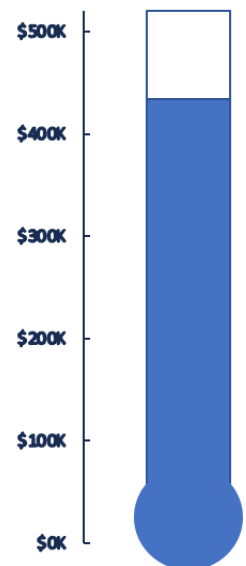
