Parish Staff Schedule for Easter Week

The parish staff will be off during the Octave of Easter (April 21-27). We will have our normal Mass schedule. Masses for Divine Mercy Sunday (April 27) will be celebrated by Fr. Jonathan Moré, a priest of the Archdiocese of Houston-Galveston. On Wednesday, April 23, daily Mass will be celebrated and confessions heard by Fr. David O'Connor from Immaculate Conception. The phone will still be answered in case of emergencies.

Divine Mercy Sunday is April 27, 2025

We will have a Holy Hour and Chanted Evensong on Sunday, April 27, beginning at 3pm.

In the Diary of St. Faustina, Jesus asked that the Feast of Divine Mercy, known today as Divine Mercy Sunday, be preceded by a Novena to The Divine Mercy. In the case of the Novena to The Divine Mercy, we pray the Chaplet of The Divine Mercy each day for a specific intention.

In three places in her *Diary*, St. Faustina records our Lord's promises of specific, extraordinary graces:

I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy (1109); Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (300); The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (699).

To receive these graces, the only condition is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the Vigil celebration) by making a good Confession beforehand and being in the state of grace and trusting in His Divine Mercy.

In addition, our Lord says through St. Faustina that we are to perform acts of mercy:

"Yes, the first Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Mercy, but there must also be acts of mercy" (742).

"The graces of My mercy are drawn by means of one vessel only, and that is trust. The more a soul trusts, the more it will receive" (1578).

The worthy reception of the Eucharist on Divine Mercy Sunday is sufficient to obtain the extraordinary graces promised by Jesus. A plenary indulgence, obtained by fulfilling the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of Supreme Pontiff), also is available.
