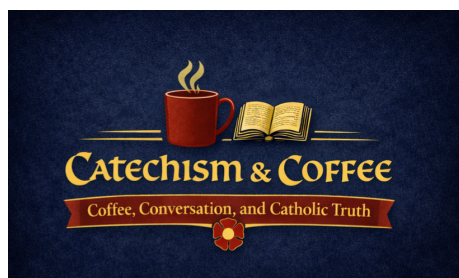

Rogation-tide begins next Sunday, May 10, and runs through Wednesday, May 13

This mini-season is a preparation for the Solemnity of the Ascension, Thursday, May 14, 40 days after Easter. **The Latin word "rogare" means "to ask" or "to request."** During these days we offer prayers and sacrifices to prepare ourselves for celebrating the Ascension of the Lord. It is also a time when we ask for God's blessing on our crops and fields, and protection of our property. We will have a procession to start the 11am Mass, and copies of the Rogation-tide prayers will be available in the narthex - these can be used at your home for asking God's blessing on your gardens and land.
