Fr. Johnson will be off through May 3. We will have our normal Mass schedule. On Wednesday, April 30, daily Mass will be celebrated and confessions heard by Fr. David O'Connor from Immaculate Conception.

Divine Mercy Sunday

This afternoon we will have a Holy Hour beginning at 3:00pm. We will pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at 3:45pm, followed by Benediction, and then chanted Evensong. The worthy reception of the Eucharist on Divine Mercy Sunday is sufficient to obtain the extraordinary graces promised by Jesus. To receive these graces, the only condition is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the Vigil celebration) by making a good Confession beforehand and being in the state of grace and trusting in His Divine Mercy. In addition, our Lord says through St. Faustina that we are to perform acts of mercy. A plenary indulgence, obtained by fulfilling the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff), also is available.

May Crowning

“Both in the East and in the West the practice of depicting the Blessed Virgin Mary wearing a regal crown came into use in the era of the Council of Ephesus (A.D. 431) [...] It is especially from the end of the 16th century that in the West the practice became widespread for the faithful, both religious and laity, to crown images of the Blessed Virgin.”

Next Sunday, May 4, we will have a May Crowning ceremony following our potluck after the 11am Mass. This will take the place of our First Sunday Holy Hour for May. The CCD classes that morning will help to make a crown; please watch e-mail and text for additional information on what supplies to bring.
